Participation:	This event is open to all players aged 14 years of age and above. We have a strict limit of 75 competitors for this event. Closing Date for entries is Wednesday 16th October 2024.  Registration & Weigh in times will be available via email to entrants as well as being posted on our social media channels @DNAjudo on Instagram & www.facebook.com/dnajudo on Monday 14th October with our first weigh in scheduled for 1.30pm.  All competitors MUST bring their <b>VALID</b> digital or physical judo license (BJA or affiliate) to registration. Fighters should bring their record book or have access to the British Judo App to evidence that they are at the grade in which they are entered.  All players will be weighed in No-Gi Judo Attire; shorts, t-shirt & belt.













Categories:	Following the weigh in players will be asked to come on to the mat for a short seminar on the rules. Whilst this seminar is taking place players will be put into pools of 3, 4, 5 or 6 based upon their age, grade, weight & competition experience with the aim to create meaningful contests and provide fighters with as much contest time as possible.
	This tournament aims to provide players with as much mat time as possible allowing them to gain more experience of competitive no-gi judo. All fighters receive a medal.
Basic Rules:	This No-Gi Judo competition will be staged using the rules set out by the British Judo Association;
	<b>Uniform -</b> Fighters must wear shorts, T-shirt / rash guard & their judo grade belt.
	<ul> <li>Scoring - Scoring will be accumulative.</li> <li>Wazari = 1 point (throw or hold.)</li> <li>Ippon = 3 points (throw or hold.)</li> <li>How to Win Outright. Contests can be determined by a 6 point gap, a Submission or Hansokumake (Direct or 3 x Accumulated Shidos).</li> <li>When the contest time expires the player with the highest score wins. If the scores are equal, the contest continues in to unlimited golden score.</li> <li>Rule changes from traditional gi judo.</li> <li>Leg grabs are allowed</li> <li>Belt grips can be held for longer as long as they are used positively.</li> </ul>
Coaches:	Coaches will be allowed matside throughout the weekend, please bring your valid coaching pass with you.
Kano Cafe:	We will again be running our Kano Cafe on the day which will be ran by our awesome team of DNA Judo volunteers to help increase funds for our club to help improve the experience of our members.
