Method of Competition	Pools. Pools/Crossover where appropriate. The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine or alter categories should entries dictate. Considerations of grade, weight and age will be considered where possible. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
Registration & Weigh In	Section A – Weigh in – 8.30 to 9.00am contest starting approx. 9.30. Section B – Weigh in times will be confirmed after the closing date by Facebook & email All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a plain white round neck t-shirt/rashguard for weigh-in and competing. Weight allowance of 0.8kg
Medals	Gold, Silver, Bronze, Bronze. In a pooled weight division, judoka must have won a contest to receive a medal.

By completing an entry form you indicate your acceptance of these conditions and parents (in the absence of any expressed objection) provide their consent to the taking and use of photos/videos.
