Eligibility	All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA or Judo Scotland. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation. Cadets: Year of birth 2008, 2009, 2010 – Contest time 4 mins. Juniors: Year of birth 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 – Contest time 4 mins. Seniors: Minimum age of 14 years – Contest time 4 mins. Masters: Minimum age of 30 years – Contest time 3 mins. All level one adaptive players are eligible to enter this event if they meet the criteria set out above. All competitors must bring their JUDO LICENCE to the weigh-in to confirm grade and eligibility. It is the competitor's responsibility to check that their License is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete. Digital licenses will need to be accessed at registration/weigh-in to show valid date			
Competition Format	Knockout & Compound Repechage System or Pools/Pools to Knockout (if fewer than 8) The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook. IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following;			

- No 30 second rule
- Judogi measurements as per 2017 IJF rules.
- 2017 IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition.

<u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event</u>; any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi must also have a white Judogi when required.

Competitors should bring their own white and blue belts for competition use.

Players must be 16 years and over to compete Maximum grade – Brown belt (1st Kyu) (Armlocks and strangles will be permitted in groups with Green (3rd Kyu) to Brown (1st Kyu) belts only).

Masters category 1: 30-39 years of age

Male -60kg, -66kgs, -73kgs, -81kgs, -90kgs, -100kgs, +100kg

Masters Category 2: 40-49 years of age

Male -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg

Masters Category 3: 50+ years of age

Male -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg

Male or Female open: Open weight category for all age/weight groups.

Format will be decided based on numbers entered

It is the judoka's responsibility to check that their membership/license is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete i.e. age and grade.

Players can change weight categories during the registration process (weight changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh in scales).

The tournament director reserves the right to amalgamate adjacent weight categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories. This includes the amalgamation of age categories in the Masters categories depending on the number of entries.
