Categories	Group 1 – Girls & Boys, Aged 5yrs Group 2 – Girls & Boys, Aged 6yrs & 7yrs This event will be run in accordance with the BJA Judo Festival Guidelines. Participants must hold a current BJA (or affiliate) membership. Participants must be aged between 6 and 7 years on the day of the event in group 2
Festival Format	All Judoka must wear ideally a white judogi and white T-shirt British Judo Technical Restrictions will be used throughout this event. The Tournament Director reserves the right the combine or alter categories should the entries or ability levels dictate. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
U8 Rules	Maximum 2 Minutes Randori - With Hikiwake scored if a draw according to BJA Policy This event will be run in accordance with the BJA Judo U8 Festival Guidelines.
Weigh In	Girls and boys to both weigh in wearing judogi trousers and t-shirt. Group 1 at <b>11am</b> and Group B <b>12noon</b> Times are provisional and will be confirmed once entry closes - and announced of our Facebook page
Entry Fee	<b>£15 Per Judoka - Spectators Free Entry – Refreshments will be available</b>
Closing Date for Entry	Friday 22 <sup>nd</sup> November 2024 or when the maximum entry of 50 has been reached.
