Group C –Men 1st kyu– weigh in 1330-1400 – Point Scoring Weight groups: -60kg /-66kg /-73kg /-81kg /- 90kg / -100kg / +100kg

Group D – Women 2nd kyu and below – weigh in 1330-1400 Weight groups: -48kg / -52kg / -57kg / -63kg / -70kg / -78kg / +78kg

Group E – Women 1st kyu – weigh in 1330-1400 – Point Scoring Weight groups: -48kg / -52kg / -57kg / -63kg / -70kg / -78kg / +78kg

- Golden score for Minors is 3 minutes (if required), pre-cadets unlimited.
- BJA rules current on 2 February 2025 will apply
- Medals will be presented throughout the day
- All competitors must always wear suitable footwear when off the mat
- Only matside qualified coaches with a valid card will be allowed matside
- Coaching will be allowed throughout the contests
- All players must weigh in with white T-shirt and judo trousers with a 0.8kg allowance being given
- Videos and photographs may be taken on the day and used to advertise the event
