Judogi	All competitors must wear a well fitting judogi during their contests, preferably plain white. All competitors must weigh in wearing a t-shirt and judogi bottoms. All female competitors <u>must</u> wear a white t-shirt under their judogi during contests. Male competitors <u>may</u> wear a white t-shirt under their judogi during contests.				
Technical Restrictions	BJA contest technical restrictions will apply to all categories at these events.				
U8's Festival Format	There will be a group warm up and games to start the festival. The main part of the Festival will then be practice 'contests' to familiarise and prepare your younger judoka for future competitions. Children will be split into pools as fairly as possible. 'Contests' in those pools will last for a fixed 2 minute period with scores accumulating, i.e. a player can be awarded multiple ippons and multiple waza-aris. The 'winner' will be decided by most overall points at the end of 2 minutes. For clarity, waza-ari will be counted as half an ippon – so 2 ippon will beat 3 waza-ari, but 3 waza-ari will beat 1 ippon. If points are equal after 2 minutes then the contest will be declared a draw. Each 2 minute contest will consist of 1 minute tachi-waza followed by 1 minute newaza. Any waza-ari or ippon throw, non-scoring throw, drop, or fall to the ground in tachi-waza will be scored appropriately and followed immediately by a matte call and restart in tachi-waza. Any ippon hold down in ne-waza will be scored appropriately followed immediately by a matte call and restart in ne-waza. All children in this group will receive participation medals. Depending on timings the Festival will conclude with some randori and/or group games.				
Red Belt Rumble format	Children will be grouped into pools as fairly as possible based on an index method taking into account age, gender, grade, and weight. Where this cannot be achieved then parents/coaches will be consulted to agree the fairest grouping for their players. Children in these groups will have 3 minute contests using standard BJA scoring system with technical restrictions. All children in these groups will receive gold / silver / bronze medals.
